A Veterans Circle and pathway made of plain and inscribed bricks is an integral part of the Park. Any man or woman who served in the armed forces can have their name inscribed on a brick for the pathway.

The park is funded in part by Minooka Summerfest proceeds and donations from businesses, individuals, and organizations.
